

Sharon Township Board Meeting Minutes

APPROVED

CALL MEETING TO ORDER: The Sharon Township Board held its regular meeting on January 2, 2014. Supervisor Psarouthakis called the meeting to order at 7:10 pm. There were 2 public attendees.

ROLL CALL: Farmer, Mikel, Psarouthakis, Simons: PRESENT Hopkins: ABSENT

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA:

Motion by Mikel to approved the agenda, supported by Simons. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF THE December 5, 2013 MINUTES and December 5, 2013 SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES:

Motion by Psarouthakis to approve the Dec 5, 2013 minutes as presented, supported by Farmer. Motion carried.
