

## Sharon Township Board Meeting Minutes

APPROVED

December 3, 2015

**CALL MEETING TO ORDER:** The Sharon Township Board held its regular meeting on December 3, 2015 at the Sharon Town Hall. Supervisor Psarouthakis called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. There were 10 public attendees. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

**ROLL CALL:** Farmer, Mikel, Psarouthakis, Simons: PRESENT Spiegel: ABSENT

### APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA:

Motion by Mikel to approve the agenda, supported by Simons. Motion approved.

### APPROVAL OF THE November 5, 2015 MINUTES:

\*\*September minutes were tabled from the last meeting for approval and will need to be tabled again for approval at the December meeting,\*\* We forgot to approve the September minutes and will table to the January meeting.

Motion by Simons to approve the minutes, supported by Mikel. Motion approved.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Compliment on the town hall renovations.

### SUPERVISORS REPORT:

Supervisor Psarouthakis reported that he is waiting to hear what the State Police say about a 4 way stop at M52 and Pleasant Lake rd. The Verizon tower is not active yet on Pleasant Lake rd. He reported having a meeting with Narconon- a drug rehab facility- that is looking to buy property on Sharon Valley- this group is affiliated with the church of scientology- they will be coming to the next Planning Commission meeting to do a short presentation.

\*\*\*CHANGE IN AGENDA\*\*\* add Sherriff Report by Lieutenant Lisa King

Lieutenant King reported that there were 29 calls, 16 were handled by the State police, and 6 by the sheriff's office and 7 calls were called off. There is an increase in calls for "barking dog complaints" and recently 1 dog bite.

**FINANCIAL REPORT:** Simons reported that taxes went out on Monday and are due without penalty/interest by February 14<sup>th</sup>. He also noted that there is now only 1 tax depository listed on the tax bills: Taxes may be dropped off to the Treasurer during his office hours (Monday from 6-7pm) in the town hall drop box in front of the hall, mailed in, or at First Merit Bank of Manchester.

Motion by Psarouthakis to approve the financial report, supported by Mikel. Motion carried.

**ZONING REPORT:** Administrator, Wilson, reported 2 new pole barns, 1 new address (for a pole barn), and 1 land split on Waldo. He had another complaint about illegal dumping- and will be following up.

**PLANNING COMISSION REPORT:** Chair, Bill Lewis reported that they have made 1 change to the recent "Natural Features Permit Application" and he is asking that the board establish a fee for that application. He reported that they are working on the Internet poles/antennas ordinances. The Next Planning Commission meeting is 12/10/15 at 7pm and the Narconon group will be presenting.

**CACA:** No meeting. No report.

### OLD BUSINESS:

**SNOW REMOVAL:** No bids came in. Psarouthakis will contact David Flores, whom the township used last year.

**TOWNSHIP WEBSITE:** Chelsea is continuing to work with the developers, the last time they called for a conference she had laryngitis and had to reschedule.

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**NEW BUSINESS:**

**No new business.**

**APPROVE BILLS:** Clerk Mikel reported that due to it only being the 3<sup>rd</sup> of the month, bills are not in yet. She has only cut payroll. She will present Decembers warrant report at the January meeting.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Discussion took place about reimbursement for the hall expenses. A request was made to put pressure to extend the natural gas pipelines throughout the township for residential use. A complaint was brought up about solicitation- Sheriff King jumped in and suggested a possible "Peddler Permit" which Dexter, AA, and Manchester use- the board will look into that.
