

## Sharon Township Board Meeting Minutes

**CALL MEETING TO ORDER:** The Sharon Township Board held its regular September meeting on September 7, 2017 at the Sharon Town Hall. Supervisor Psarouthakis called the meeting to order at 7:03pm. There were 18 public attendees. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

**Roll Call:** Mikel, Psarouthakis, Simons: PRESENT Guysky & Cooper: ABSENT

**APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA:** Motion by Mikel to approve the September 7, 2017 agenda, supported by Simons. Motion approved.

**APPROVAL OF THE August 3, 2017 MINUTES, August 3, 2017 CLOSED SESSION MINUTS, and the AUGUST 14, 2017 SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES:** Motion by Psarouthakis to approve the August 3, 2017 regular minutes, closed session minutes, and August 14<sup>th</sup> Special Meeting minutes, supported by Simons. Motion approved.

**FINANCIAL REPORT:** Taxes are due by September 14<sup>th</sup> without penalty, Winter taxes go out December 1<sup>st</sup>.

Motion by Psarouthakis to approve the financial report, supported by Mikel. Motion approved.

**ZONING REPORT:** Zoning Administrator Wilson reported 2 new pole barns and 1 land split. No new complaints. Short update on fireworks complaint and wandering dog issue.

**PLANNING COMISSION REPORT:** Bill Lewis reported reviewing on the Master Plan and working on sending out a resident survey.

**CACA:** Soil erosion employee- DNR attorney making every township have soil erosion as a township employee. Donna Lasinskis office is talking to the attorney general.

**ZBA REPORT:** Member had to resign, looking for a new ZBA board member.

### OLD BUSINESS:

- a. **Internet:** we've been referred to Attorney to discuss ballot language, gave update on Lyndon Townships ballot APPROVAL, project will be on the May 2018 Ballot.
- b. **Bethel Church Update:** the Road Commission would like to know if Sharon Twp is willing to move forward with the project, given the cost Supervisor Psarouthakis also suggested the possibility of doing nothing, in the meantime, until funds are available in the future. With 2 board members absent, it was suggested to table this discussion until next meeting.
- c. **MMA:** Update: LARA meeting last month. Discussion on closing city dispensaries, update on the "recreational use petition" circulating for the Fall 2018 ballot.

### NEW BUSINESS:

- a. **ZBA:** mentioned above, need a new ZBA member
- b. **Upcoming elections: We NEED election workers for upcoming elections, NOVEMBER 7 and MAY 2018.**

**REMINDER: 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Picnic:** The Township Picnic will be September 23<sup>rd</sup> from 12-4pm at the Sharon Town Hall. Small discussion took place.

Motion by Cooper to approve \$500 in spending money for supplies for the picnic, supported by Guysky. Motion approved.

**APPROVAL OF THE BILLS:** Mikel presented the August warrant report and September payroll.

Motion by Psarouthakis to approve the August 2017 warrant report and September payroll, supported by Simons. Motion approved.
