Walker Road house: a neighboring citizen expressed an interest in purchasing and rehabbing house but was unaware of the condition. Motion by Guysky to demolish, seconded by Psarothakis, passed unanimously.

BILLS Motion to approve by Guysky, seconded by Cooper passed unanimously.

Guysky made a motion to hold a special open meeting about the Medical Marihuana Ordinance, seconded by Cooper, all approved.
